NOTICE OF RACE

The Regatta will be organized by the ESTONIAN DRAGON ASSOCIATION (EDA) in cooperation with Kalev Yacht Club.

1. RULES.

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Under RRS 87, the Class Rule 13.30 the crew weight restriction will not apply.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising will conform to the current WS Regulation 20 and the Class Rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The Series is open to all boats of the Dragon class.

3. FEES

- 3.1. The Entry Fee will be 180€ per boat.
- 3.2. Participants may pay the entry fee by cash in the Race Office upon registration; credit cards cannot be accepted.

5. THE COURSES

The course to be sailed will be windward-leeward configuration with fleet racing. Spreader marks will and leeward gates may be used. If the windward mark is moved during a race, there will be no spreader mark.

6. MEASUREMENTS AND INSPECTIONS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

7.1 Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 8.2 24 races are schedulled. 9 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.3 (a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When eight or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worsts scores.

7. PRIZES

There will be prizes awarded for the first three places in the Series.

8. INSURANCE

Boats taking part in the races shall have valid adequate third party insurance.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

10. VENUE

The Kalev Yacht Club base is located at Pirita tee 17, 11911 Tallinn, Estonia.
